Preface

This is an overview study of the Reign of Jesus Christ, His Second Advent and Messianic Kingdom, using Scripture Texts selected by the author, with appropriate excerpts, summaries and examples. There are many other confirming prophecies throughout Scripture.

This study covers Prophecies predicting Messiah's Kingdom spoken/written by the Lord's Anointed Spokesmen (Prophets/Psalmists) in the Poetic/Wisdom and Prophetic Books of the Old Testament, as well as Prophecies from the New Testament.

PART I - MESSIANIC KINGDOM TODAY

A. Messiah's Kingdom on Earth

1. Jesus Christ Our Lord & Savior

- a. Jesus Christ Completely Provided the Way of Salvation for Mankind
 - 1) Jesus Declares: “**I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.**” John 14:6
 - 2) Upon His Death Jesus Declared: “**It is finished**” John 19:30
 - a) Jesus Christ has Fully Completed His Earthly Life, Ministry & Sacrifice.
 - b) Jesus Christ has Fulfilled All the Law (Including its Sacrificial Offerings) and the Prophets.
 - 3) Jesus Christ Is the Only Means of Salvation. “There is no salvation through anyone else, nor is there any other name under heaven given to the human race by which we are to be saved.” Acts 4:12
 - 4) Jesus Christ Paid the Price in Full for Our Salvation. “You (*Christians*) have been purchased at a price (*Blood of Jesus Christ*)” 1 Cor. 6:20

2. Jesus Christ Commissions His Church

- a. Jesus Christ Commissions His Church (Us) to Gather as Many People as Possible into His Kingdom by Proclaiming His Gospel.
 - 1) Jesus: “**All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.**” Matt. 28:18-20
 - 2) Jesus: “**Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned. These signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will drive out demons, they will speak new languages. They will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing, it will not harm them. They will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.**” Mark 16:15-18

3. Jesus Christ Empowers His Church

- a. Jesus Christ Empowers His Church to Proclaim His Gospel by Sending the Holy Spirit.
 - 1) Jesus' Promise & Commission: “**But you will receive power when the holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.**” Acts 1:8
 - a) Jesus Christ then Ascends into Heaven & Enthroned Acts 1:9; Heb. 1:1-4
 - b) Jesus Christ Sends the Holy Spirit (Birth of the Church) Acts 2:1-4

4. Jesus Christ is Enthroned in Heaven (See Part I.B Below)

- a. Jesus Christ is Enthroned in Heaven, Interceding for His People, Working In & Through His People, and Awaiting the Completion of his Church (Kingdom).
 - 1) Jesus: “**And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached throughout the world as a witness to all nations, and then the end will come.**” Matt. 24:14

B. Reign of Messiah-King Today

1. Christ Jesus Enthroned in Heaven

Heb. 1

- a. “In times past (*Old Covenant*), God spoke in partial and various ways to our ancestors (*Hebrews*) through the prophets; in these last days (*New Covenant*), he spoke to us through a son (*Messiah Jesus*), whom he made heir of all things and through whom he created the universe, who is the refulgence (*Reflection*) of his glory, the very imprint of his being, and who sustains all things by his mighty word.....” (*Heb. 1:1-3*)
 - 1) Christ Jesus is the Son of God
 - 2) Christ Jesus is the Word of God
 - 3) Christ Jesus is Heir of All Creation
 - 4) Christ Jesus is Creator & Sustainer of the Universe
- b. “..... When he (*Jesus Christ*) had accomplished purification from sins (*Sacrifice on Cross*), he took his seat at the right hand of the Majesty on high, as far superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.” (*Heb. 1:3-4*)
 - 1) Christ Jesus is the Savior of Mankind
 - 2) Christ Enthroned at Right Hand of Majesty (*Father God Almighty*) in Heaven
 - 3) Christ Jesus Superior to Heavenly Hosts
- c. Messiah’s Supreme Enthronement
 - 1) Messiah Enthroned as Son of God. “For to which of the angels did God ever say: ‘You are my son; this day I have begotten you’? Or again: ‘I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me’?” (*Heb. 1:5*)
 - 2) Angels Worship Messiah. “And again, when he (*Father God*) leads the first-born into the world (*God the Son Became Jesus Christ – Son of Man*), he says: ‘Let all the angels of God worship him’.” (*Heb. 1:6*)
 - 3) Messiah’s Eternal & Righteous Reign. “..... ‘Your throne, O God (*Messiah–King & Son of God*), stands forever and ever; and a righteous scepter is the scepter of your kingdom. You loved justice and hated wickedness; therefore God (*Messiah–King & Son of God*), your God (*Father God*), anointed you with the oil of gladness above your companions’ (*Jesus’ Throne is Superior to All Other Powers & Authorities*)” (*Heb. 1:9*)
 - 4) Messiah Eternal & Immutable Creator. “..... ‘At the beginning, O Lord, you established the earth, and the heavens are the works of your hands. They will perish, but you remain; and they will all grow old like a garment. You will roll them up like a cloak, and like a garment they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will have no end.’” (*Heb. 1:10-12*)
 - 5) Father God to His Son – Jesus Christ Our Lord. “..... ‘Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies your footstool’” (*Heb. 1:13*)
 - 6) Angels Minister to Messiah’s Followers (Church). “Are they (*Angles*) not all ministering spirits sent to serve, for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?” (*Heb. 1:14*)

2. Christ Jesus Exalted Above All Creation

Phil. 2:5-11

- a. Christ Jesus’ Obedience & Victory. “Have among yourselves the same attitude that is also yours in Christ Jesus, Who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in

appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross.”

- b. Christ’s Exaltation (Glorification). “Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that JESUS CHRIST IS LORD, to the glory of God the Father.”

3. Vision of Glorified Christ

Rev. 1 - 3

- a. John's Vision of Glorified Christ. “..... I saw seven gold lampstands and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, wearing an ankle-length robe, with a gold sash around his chest. The hair of his head was as white as white wool or as snow, and his eyes were like a fiery flame. His feet were like polished brass refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the sound of rushing water. In his right hand he held seven stars. A sharp two-edged sword came out of his mouth, and his face shone like the sun at its brightest.” (*Rev. 1:12-16*)
- 1) Jesus Christ the Center of His Church/Christianity
 - a) Seven (*Perfect Completion*) Gold (*Belonging to God*) Lampstands (*HOLDERS OF LIGHT/SPIRIT*) = The Church (*All of Christianity*)
 - b) Midst of Lampstands (*Entire Christian Church*) One (*Godhead - Fullness of God*) like the Son of Man (*Jesus Christ*)
 - 2) Jesus Christ’s Appearance
 - a) Ankle Length Robe = Christ is High Priest
 - b) Sash of Gold = Christ is King
 - c) White Hair = Christ is Eternal
 - d) Eyes Like Fiery Flame = Christ is Omniscient (*All Knowing*)
 - e) Feet of Polished Brass = Christ is Established & Immutable (*Never Changing – He is Forever Perfect*)
 - f) Voice Like Rushing Water = Christ Speaks with Divine Authority
 - g) Seven Stars in Right Hand = Christ Controls Presiding Spirits of His Church
 - h) Two Edged Sword Came Out of His Mouth = Christ is the Word of God (*Old & New Covenants*)
 - i) Face Shone with Brightness of the Sun = Divine Majesty of Christ
- b. John (*Church*) Prostrates Himself before Christ Jesus
- 1) Christ Identifies Himself to John. “..... **Do not be afraid. I am the first and the last, the one who lives. Once I was dead, but now I am alive forever and ever. I hold the keys to death and the netherworld.**” (*Rev. 1:17-18*)
 - a) “**Do Not be Afraid**” (*Christ’s Perfect Love Casts Out Fear*)
 - b) “**I AM the First and the Last, the One Who Lives**” (*Christ is the Eternal Living God*)
 - c) “**Once I was Dead (Christ Died on the Cross), but Now I AM Alive Forever and Ever.**” (*Christ Resurrected & Living*)
 - d) “**I Hold the Keys of Death & Netherworld.**” (*Christ is the Only Way of Salvation – He is the Righteous & Final Judge*)
 - 2) Christ Instructs John. “**Write down, therefore, what you have seen, and what is happening (Present – Written 96 AD), and what will happen afterwards (Future). This is the secret meaning of the seven stars you saw in my right hand, and of the seven gold lampstands: the seven stars are the angels of the**

seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches.”

(Rev. 1:19-20)

- a) Christ Tells John (Church) to be His Witness
 - b) Seven Stars = Presiding Spirits of the Churches
 - c) Seven Lampstands = Types / Eras of Churches Within & Throughout Christianity
- c. Christian Age Rev. 2 & 3
- 1) Jesus Christ's Messages to Seven Churches
 - a) Christ's Special Revelation of Himself to Each Church
 - b) Sequentially Unfolding God's Plan to His Church
 - c) Encouraging, Warning, Correcting & Promises to Each Church
4. Vision of the Heavenly Throne Rev. 4 & 5
- a. John Caught Up to Heaven Rev. 4:1-2a
 - 1) Hearing a Voice: “Come up here and I will show you what must happen afterwards.” (Rev. 4:1b)
 - b. John Sees a Throne in Heaven Rev. 4:2b-11
 - 1) On Throne Sat “ONE” (*Godhead = Father, Son & Holy Spirit*)
 - a) Appearance Sparkling like Jasper & Carnelian
 - 2) Around Throne a Halo (Rainbow*) as Brilliant Emerald
[* New American Bible 1970 Version & King James Version Use “Rainbow”]
(Rainbow is Sign of Lord's Covenant with All Nations. Gen. 9)
 - 3) Surrounding Throne were 24 Elders Sitting on Thrones
(Appointed Leaders/Witnesses)
 - a) 12 Tribes of Israel (Old Covenant – Israel)
 - b) 12 Apostles (New Covenant – Church)
 - c) Dressed in White Garments (Sanctified/Purified)
 - d) Gold Crowns on Heads (God Given Authority to Rule)
 - 4) From Throne Came Flashes of Lightning, Rumbblings & Peals of Thunder
(God's Proclamation – Word of God)
 - 5) In Front of Throne were 7 Flaming Torches
 - a) 7 Spirits of God (7 Churches = Entire Christianity)
 - 6) In Front of Throne a Sea of Glass like Crystal
(Pure & Complete Reflection of God) (Nothing Hidden or Obscure)
 - 7) In Center & Around Throne were 4 Living Creatures (Cherubim – Throne Attendants) (Hierarchy of Creation)
 - a) Cherubim Continually Exclaim: “Holy, holy, holy (Worship of Trinity) is the Lord God almighty (Omnipotent), who was (Jesus' Life on Earth), and who is (Jesus Resurrected & Glorified), and who is to come (Second Coming of Jesus Christ).” (Rev. 4:8b)
 - b) 24 Elders (Covenant Witnesses)
 - Fell Down before the ONE Seated on Throne & Worshiped Him
 - Throw Down their Crowns before Throne
(Submissive to God's Authority)
 - Exclaim: “Worthy are you, Lord our God (Covenant Making God), to receive glory and honor and power (Worthy of Ultimate Praise), for you created all things (Ultimate Creator); because of your will they came to be and were created (Sovereign Lord).” (Rev. 4:11)

c. John Sees a Scroll & Lamb of God Rev. 5

- 1) Scroll in Right Hand of ONE Seated on Throne
(Scroll in Lord God Almighty's Control)
(Scroll is Deed to Lord's Inheritance – Israel & Earth)
(Law of Redemption of Property by a Kinsman-Redeemer. Lev. 25:22-55)
 - a) Scroll had Writing on Both Sides (*Old & New Covenants*)
 - b) Scroll Sealed with 7 Seals (*Perfectly & Completely Sealed*)

Note. Jesus Opens these Seals later in the Book of Revelation, Revealing Mankind's Future:

- 6 Seals = Revelation of Man's Final Rule on Earth [Rev. 6]
- Final Inheritors of Christ's Kingdom [Rev. 7]
- 7th Seal = Prophecy "Silence in Heaven"- Messiah to Return from Heaven to Rule Earth [Rev. 8:1-2]

- 2) Mighty Angel Loudly Proclaims: "Who is worthy to open the scroll and break its seals?" (*Rev. 5:2b*)
 - a) No One Found Worthy to Break Seals & Open Scroll (*Who has Authority to Claim Lord's Inheritance & Reveal its Culmination?*)
 - No One in Heaven (*Angelic Creation*)
 - No One on Earth (*Human Creation*)
 - No One Under Earth (*The Dead, Satan & Demons, etc.*)
 - b) John Weeps Because No One was Worthy to Open Scroll
 - c) One of Elders Said to John: "Do not weep. The lion of the tribe of Judah (*Israel's Promised/Anointed One*), the root of David (*King of Kings – Messiah*), has triumphed (*Conquering Sin & Death*), enabling him to open the scroll with its seven seals (*Jesus Bridged the Gap Between Heaven & Earth*)." (*Rev. 5:5b*)
- 3) John Sees a Lamb Standing in Midst of Throne (*The Lamb is Divine*)
 - a) Lamb Seems to Have Been Slain
(Lamb is Lord God's Holy, Spotless & Perfect Sacrifice – Jesus Christ)
 - b) Lamb had 7 Horns (*Rules with Absolute Authority*) & 7 Eyes (*All Seeing*)
 - 7 Spirits of God Sent to Whole World (*Universal Christianity*)
 - c) Lamb Received Scroll from ONE Seated on Throne (*Lord's Inheritance is Placed in Jesus Christ's Hands – Future Placed in Jesus' Hands*)
- 4) Lamb Took the Scroll and is Worshiped
 - a) Cherubim (*Throne Attendants*) & 24 Elders (*Old & New Covenants Witnesses*) Prostrated Themselves Before Lamb
 - Each Elder Held Harp (*Implements of Praise*) & Gold Bowls Filled with Incense (*Prayers of God's People*)
 - Sang a New Hymn: "Worthy are you (*Lamb of God*) to receive the scroll and to break open its seals, for you were slain and with your blood you purchased for God those from every tribe and tongue, people and nation (*Israel's Kinsman-Redeemer & Christ Our Savior*). You made them a kingdom (*Christ Our King*) and priests (*Christ Our High Priest*) for our God, and they will reign on earth" (*Rev. 5:9b-10*)
 - b) Angelic Host Accompany Cherubim & Elders: "Worthy is the Lamb (*Jesus Christ*) that was slain (*Crucified*) to receive power and riches, wisdom and strength, honor and glory and blessing (*Glorified Savior*)." (*Rev. 5:12b*)
 - c) Every Creature (*All Creation*) Cried Out: "To the one who sits on the

throne and to the Lamb (*Jesus Christ*) be blessing and honor, glory and might, forever and ever (*Godhead Praised Together as Lord God Almighty*).” (*Rev. 5:13b*)

- In Heaven (*All Angelic Hosts & Saints*)
 - On Earth (*Terrestrial Creation – Mankind*)
 - Under the Earth (*The Dead, Satan, Demons & Christ’s Enemies*)
 - In the Sea (*The Gentile Nations*)
 - Everything in the Universe
- d) Cherubim Answered: “Amen!” (*So Be It – YES!*)
- Elders Fell Down & Worshiped God & His Lamb

Note. Worship is reserved exclusively for the Lord God Almighty. It is a Divine Prerogative. Here we see God’s Throne Attendants, Ordained Witness of the Old and New Covenants, and all Celestial, Terrestrial and Extraterrestrial Creation worshiping the Lamb of God (*Jesus Christ*), proclaiming His Divinity.

5. Christ Jesus Head of the Church 1 Cor. 12:12-31; Eph. 1:22-23; Eph. 4:1-16
- a. Preeminence of Christ Jesus. “He (*Jesus Christ*) is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For in him were created all things in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers; all things were created through him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. He is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn (*Resurrected*) from the dead, that in all things he himself might be preeminent. For in him all the fullness was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile all things for him, making peace by the blood of his cross.”
Col. 1:15-20
- b. Mystical Body of Christ.
- 1) “As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.”
(*1 Cor. 12:12-13*)
 - 2) “And he (*Father God*) put all things beneath his (*Jesus Christ’s*) feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of the one who fills all things in every way.” (*Eph. 1:22-23*)
 - 3) “And he gave some as apostles, others as prophets, others as evangelists, others as pastors and teachers, to equip the holy ones for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of faith and knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the extent of the full stature of Christ, living the truth in love, we should grow in every way into him who is the head, Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, with the proper functioning of each part, brings about the body’s growth and builds itself up in love.”
(*Eph. 4:11-16*)
- c. Christ Jesus – Source of Church. “**I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and everyone that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit (*Good Works Furthering His Kingdom*). Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever remains in me and I in him**”

will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing.” John 15:1-8

6. Christ Our High Priest

Exclusive Duties of Israel's High Priests are to 1) Offer Sacrifices for the Atonement of Sins, and 2) Intercede to Lord God in Behalf of the People of Israel.

- a. Jesus Ordained High Priest by Father God Heb. 5:1-10
 - 1) “Every high priest is taken from among men and made their representative before God, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins.” (*Heb. 5:1*)
 - 2) In the same way, it was not Christ who glorified himself in becoming high priest, but rather the one (*Father God*) who said to him (*Messiah – Son of God*): ‘You are my son; this day I have begotten you (*Psa. 2:7*)’; just as he says in another place: ‘You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek (*Psa. 110:4*).’” (*Heb. 5:5-6*)
 - 3) “Son (*Jesus Christ – Son of God*) though he was, he learned obedience from what he suffered (*Christ's Passion & Death*); and when he was made perfect (*Evidenced by Christ's Resurrection from Dead*), he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him, declared by God high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.” (*Heb. 5:8-10*)
- b. Jesus' Sacrificial Offering for the Atonement of Sin. “Now since the children share in blood and flesh, he (*Jesus Christ*) likewise shared in them, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and free those who through fear of death had been subject to slavery all their life. therefore, he had to become like his brothers in every way, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest before God to expiate (*Atone for*) the sins of the people. Because he himself was tested through what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested.” Heb. 2:14-18
- c. Jesus Our Compassionate High Priest & Intercessor. “Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast to our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who has similarly been tested in every way, yet without sin. So let us confidently approach the throne of grace to receive mercy and to find grace for timely help.” Heb. 4:14-16
- d. Jesus Mediator Between Father God & Man. “For there is one God. There is also one mediator between God and the human race, Christ Jesus, himself human, who gave himself as ransom for all.” 1 Tim. 2:5-6
- e. Jesus Perfecter of Our Faith. “Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith. For the sake of the joy that lay before him he endured the cross, despising its shame, and has taken his seat at the right of the throne of God.” Heb. 12:1-2

C. Promise of Messiah's Return to Earth

1. Promise to His Church

- a. Blessed Hope of the Church Titus 2:11-14
 - 1) “For the grace of God has appeared, saving all and training us to reject godless ways and worldly desires and to live temperately, justly, and devoutly in this age, as we await the blessed hope, the appearance of the glory of the great God

and of our savior Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to deliver us from all lawlessness and to cleanse for himself a people as his own, eager to do what is good.”

- b. As Jesus Ascended from Earth into Heaven
So, Jesus will Return to Earth from Heaven Acts 1:9-11
 - 1) Angelic Pronouncement at Jesus’ Ascension: “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”
- c. Promise to Take His People Out of this World (“Catch Away” or “Rapture”) Luke 17:20-37; 1 Cor. 15:50-58; 1 Thess. 4:13-17
 - 1) Jesus Promises His Disciples (Church): “**Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father’s house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be.**”
John 14:1-3
 - 2) Jesus Christ is Coming:
 - a) To Receive Us unto Himself
 - b) To Unite Us with Himself as His Bride Rev. 19:6-10
 - c) So We Can Live with Him Forever
- d. Jesus’ Return for His Church is Imminent (At Any Time) Luke 12:35-40
 - 1) Not Conditioned Upon Any Prior Event, Prophetic Announcement or Fulfillment
 - 2) Time Known Only to Father God Matt. 24:36-42; Acts 1:6-7
 - a) “**But of that day and hour (Of His Coming) no one knows, neither the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone.**” (Matt. 24:36)
 - 3) Christ will Come Suddenly & Unexpectedly Matt. 24:43-51; 1 Thess. 5:1-11
 - a) “Concerning times and seasons, brothers, you have no need for anything to be written to you. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief at night.” (1 Thess. 5:1-2)
 - b) “Behold, I tell you a mystery. We shall not all fall asleep, but we will all be changed, in an instant, in the blink of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.” (1 Cor. 15:51-52)
 - 4) We are to Expand His Kingdom & Wait for His Return 1 Thess. 1:9-10
 - 5) Glorified Christ to His Church: “**Yes, I am coming soon.**” Rev. 22:20
Church Answers Our Lord: “Amen! Come, Lord Jesus!”

2. Promise to Israel

- a. Restoration of Promise Land Ezek. 36:1-15
(*Deliverance of Land from Foreign Oppression - Starting 1918*)
 - 1) Preparing Land for God’s Chosen People - Israel
- b. Restoration of God’s Chosen People Ezek. 36:16 – 37:14

PART II - MESSIAH'S COMING KINGDOM

A. Messiah's Second Coming

1. Christ Returns for His Church (See Following Note)

Note. The term "Church", used in this study, does not refer to any denomination, religious order or sect; but to those individual people throughout the age, who:

- 1) Recognize themselves as sinners in need of forgiveness [Rom. 3:23],
- 2) Recognize Jesus Christ as God's only begotten Son [John 3:16-18],
- 3) Believe that Christ Jesus gave His life to save sinners [Rom. 10:9-10; 1 Pet. 2:21-24],
- 4) Repent and ask the Lord to forgive their sins [1 John 1:8-9],
- 5) Personally accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior inviting Him into their lives [Acts 16:30-31],
- 6) Receive the Holy Spirit [Rom. 8:1-2; 1 Cor. 3:16], and
- 7) Confess Jesus as Lord and Savior [Matt. 10:32].

Such people are "born again" into the family of God [John 3:1-8], becoming children of God [John 1:12] and heirs of Christ's Kingdom [Rom. 8:14-17; Gal. 4:1-7]. It is these people who collectively are Christ's "Church" [1 Cor. 12; Eph. 2:11-22].

- 3) Messiah-King Comes to Rescue Israel (*God’s Chosen Nation*)
 - a) The Lord’s Vengeance on Israel’s Enemies Zeph. 1
 - b) Battle of Armageddon Concluded - Old Testament Prophecies:
Isa. 13 & 14; Ezek. 39; Zech. 12:4-9; Zech. 14:1-5; Zech. 14:12-15
 - The Lord Fights & Conquers the Nations. “Then the LORD shall go forth and fight against those nations, fighting as on a day of battle.” (Zech. 14:3)
 - Messiah Stands on Mount of Olives. “That day his (Messiah’s) feet shall rest upon the Mount of Olives, which is opposite Jerusalem to the east.....” (Zech. 14:4)
 - Messiah Leads the Armies of Heaven. “..... Then the LORD, my God, shall come, and all his holy ones with him (*People Gained for His Kingdom throughout Ages - See Part II.A.1 Above*).” (Zech. 14:5)
 - Lord’s Plague on Armies Attacking Jerusalem. “And this shall be the plague with which the LORD shall strike all the nations that have fought against Jerusalem: their flesh shall rot while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall rot in their sockets, and their tongues shall rot in their mouths (*Physical Degeneration*). On that day there shall be among them a great tumult from the LORD (*Lord’s Battle Cry*): every man shall seize the hand of his neighbor, and the hand of each shall be raised against that of his neighbor (*Confusion & Infighting*).” (Zech. 14:12-13)
 - Judah Shall Fight Against Jerusalem. “Judah also shall fight against Jerusalem (*Overthrow Occupying Armies*).” (Zech. 14:14a)
 - Israel Gathers Riches of Gentile Nations. “The riches of all the surrounding nations shall be gathered together, gold, silver, and garments, in great abundance.” (Zech. 14:14b)

c) Second Coming of Messiah - King of Kings (*Christ Conquers the Earth*) -
New Covenant Revelation Rev. 19:11 – 20:3

(1) Revelation of Jesus Christ (*Second Coming of Messiah to Earth*).

“Then I saw the heavens opened, and there was a white horse; its rider was (called) ‘Faithful and True.’ He judges and wages war in righteousness. His eyes were (like) a fiery flame, and on his head were many diadems. He had a name inscribed that no one knows except himself. He wore a cloak that had been dipped in blood, and his name was called the Word of God. The armies of heaven followed him, mounted on white horses and wearing clean white linen. - He will Tread Out Winepress of Fury & Wrath of God Almighty
(*Christ the Omnipotent Warrior - Executes God’s Judgments*)
- Name on His Cloak Covering Thigh (*Symbol of God’s Covenants*)
"KING OF KING & LORD OF LORDS"

(2) Battle of Armageddon Rev. 19:17 – 20:3

- Lord’s Preparation for Final Conflict. “Then I saw an angel standing on the sun. He cried out (in) a loud voice to all the birds flying high overhead (*Between Heaven & Earth*), ‘Come here. Gather for God’s great feast, to eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of military officers, and the flesh of warriors, the flesh of horses and of their riders (*Mankind’s Authorities & Might*), and the flesh of

all, free and slave, small and great (*Unrepentant Mankind*).”
(*Rev. 19:17-18*)

- Man Musters His Armies for Final Confrontation to Rule Earth. “Then I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies (*Antichrist & His Allies*) gathered to fight against the one riding the horse (*Messiah - Son of God*) and against his (*Heavenly*) army.” (*Rev. 19:19*)
 - Messiah’s Victory:
 - “The beast (*Antichrist*) was caught and with it the false prophet (*Satanic Religious Leader*) The two were thrown alive into the fiery pool burning with sulfur (*Eternal Damnation in Hell’s Lake of Fire*).” (*Rev. 19:20*)
 - “The rest (*Mankind’s Armies Allied with Antichrist*) were killed by the sword that came out of the mouth of the one riding the horse (*Messiah Pronounces Judgment*), and all the birds gorged themselves on their flesh (*Mankind’s Rebellion Completely Devoured - Cleansing the Earth*).” (*Rev. 19:21*)
 - Satan’s Expulsion from Earth. “Then I saw an angel come down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the abyss and a heavy chain. He seized the dragon, the ancient serpent, which is the Devil or Satan, and tied it up for a thousand years and threw it into the abyss, which he locked over it and sealed, so that it could no longer lead the nations astray” (*Rev. 20:1-3*)
 - Abyss = Bottomless Pit (*Place of No Escape*)
- b. Salvation of a People (Israel)
- Israel Shall Proclaim: “Yeshua hoo hamashiach” = Jesus Our Messiah*
- 1) Israel’s Spiritual Blindness Lifted Rom. 11:25-29
 - a) “..... a hardening (*Blindness*) has come upon Israel in part, until the full number of the Gentiles comes in (*See Part II.A.1 Above*), and thus all Israel will be saved” (*Rom. 11:25-26*)
 - 2) Israel Recognizes Yeshua (Jesus) as Messiah at His Coming Zech. 12:10
 - a) “I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem (*Israelites*) a spirit of grace and petition; and they shall look on him whom they have thrust through (*Jesus Christ Crucified*), and they shall mourn for him as one mourns for an only son (*Jesus - Israelite of Tribe of Judah & Son of David*), and they shall grieve over him as one grieves over a first-born” (*Law Requires that Israel’s First-Born be Consecrated to Lord [Ex. 13:1-2]. Jesus is Lord’s First Born [Luke 2:22-35].*)”
 - b) Israel’s Repentance Zech. 12:11-14
 - “On that day the mourning in Jerusalem shall be as great as the mourning of Hadadrimmon in the plain of Megiddo (*Referring to Messiah’s Victory at Battle of Armageddon*).” (*Zech. 12:11*)
 - 3) Purification & Redemption of Israel – Aftermath of Armageddon
Isa. 1:21-31; Zeph. 3
 - a) Lord Provides Israel’s Salvation Isa. 59
 - Israel’s Sin & Conviction. “Lo, the hand of the LORD is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear. Rather, it is your crimes (*Conspiracy, Arrest, Trial & Conviction of Jesus Christ*) that separate

you from your God, It is your sins that make him hide his face so that he will not hear you.” (*Isa. 59:1-2*)

- Israel’s Redeemer – Messiah. “He (*Lord*) shall come to Zion a redeemer to those of Jacob (*Israel*) who turn from sin (*Repent*), says the LORD.” (*Isa. 59:20*)
 - b) Messiah is Israel’s Savior Isa. 61:10-11
 - c) Messiah is Israel’s Bridegroom Isa. 62:1-5
 - d) Purification of Israel Zech. 13
 - Fountain (*Holy Spirit*) Purifies from Sin & Uncleaness
 - Open to House of David & Inhabitants of Jerusalem (*Israel*)
 - The Lord Purges Idols (*False Gods*) & False Prophets (*False / Misguided Teachers*) from Israel
 - Israel’s Song of Salvation. “..... They (*Israel*) shall call upon my name (*Yeshua hoo hamashiach*), and I will hear them. I will say, ‘They are my people,’ and they shall say, ‘The LORD is my God.’” (*Zech. 13:9*)
- 4) The Lord’s Forgiveness - Israel’s “Day of Atonement” Fulfilled by Messiah
Lev. 16; Lev. 23:26-32
(*See Day of Atonement in “Holy Days, Festivals & Feasts – Part II” Study*)
- a) Messiah – Israel’s High Priest Heb. 4:14-16; Heb. 9 & 10
 - Clothed in His Own Righteousness
 - Offered Himself as a Holy & Perfect Sacrifice
 - Entered Heavenly Sanctuary with His Own Blood for Sins of His Household (Israel)
 - Messiah was the Scapegoat that Carried Away Their Sins
Psa. 103:11-18
 - b) Israel Accepts Lord God’s Atonement - Messiah Isa. 12
 - “On that day, you will say: I give you thanks, O LORD; though you have been angry with me, your anger has abated, and you have consoled me. God (*Elohim – Creator*) indeed is my savior; I am confident and unafraid. My strength and my courage is the LORD (*Yahweh*), and he has been my savior.” (*Isa. 12:1-3*)
 - “With joy you will draw water (*Holy Spirit*) at the fountain of salvation, and say on that day (*Messiah’s Second Advent – Israel’s Day of Atonement*): Give thanks to the LORD, acclaim his name; among the nations make known his deeds, proclaim how exalted is his name. Sing praise to the LORD for his glorious achievement; let this be known throughout all the earth. Shout with exultation, O city of Zion (*Jerusalem*), for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel (*Messiah – Savior*)!” (*Isa. 12:3-6*)
- c. Manner of Messiah’s Coming
- 1) Excerpts from Old Testament Prophecies
 - a) “..... Then the moon will blush and the sun grow pale”
Isa. 24:15-23
 - b) “And I will work wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood, fire, and columns of smoke; The sun will be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, At the coming of the Day of the LORD, the great and terrible day.....”
Joel 3:3-5

- c) “..... For see, the LORD comes forth from his place (*Heaven*), he descends and treads upon the heights of the earth. The mountains melt under him and the valleys split open, Like wax before the fire, like water poured down a slope.” Micah 1:2-4
- d) “..... That day his (*Messiah's*) feet shall rest upon the Mount of Olives, which is opposite Jerusalem to the east. The Mount of Olives shall be cleft in two from east to west by a very deep valley, and half of the mountain shall move to the north and half of it to the south. And the valley of the LORD'S mountain shall be filled up when the valley of those two mountains reaches its edge; Then the LORD, my God, shall come, and all his holy ones with him.” Zech. 14:1-5
- 2) Excerpts of Messiah's Words
- a) Jesus' Prophetic Discourse
- “Immediately after the tribulation of those days, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from the sky, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. - “.....you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of the Power and coming on the clouds of heaven.”

- 3) Excerpts from New Testament Prophecies
- a) Sixth Seal – Messiah Son of Man Returns to Earth Ending Man's Rule Rev. 6:12-17
- “..... there was a great earthquake; the sun turned as black as dark sackcloth and the whole moon became like blood. The stars in the sky fell to the earth like unripe figs shaken loose from the tree in a strong wind. Then the sky was divided like a torn scroll curling up, and every mountain and island was moved from its place.....”
- b) Seventh Trumpet – Heaven's Proclamation of Coming Messiah Lord & Ruler of World Rev. 11:15-19
- “..... There were loud voices in heaven (*Angelic Hosts*), saying, ‘The kingdom of the world now belongs to our Lord and to his Anointed (*Messiah*), and he will reign forever and ever.’”
 - “The twenty-four elders (*Representing Old & New Covenants*) who

sat on their thrones before God prostrated themselves and worshiped God and said: ‘We give thanks to you, Lord God almighty, who are and who were. For you have assumed your great power and have established your reign. The nations raged, but your wrath has come, and the time for the dead to be judged, and to recompense your servants, the prophets, and the holy ones and those who fear your name, the small and the great alike, and to destroy those who destroy the earth.’”

- “Then God’s temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant (*Lord’s Throne on Earth - Fulfilled by Messiah*) could be seen in the temple. There were flashes of lightning, rumblings, and peals of thunder, an earthquake, and a violent hailstorm.”
- c) Seventh Bowl – Coming of Messiah to Effect God’s Wrath & Final Judgment on Earth Rev. 16:17-21
- “..... A loud voice came out of the temple from the throne (*Lord God’s Pronouncement*), saying, ‘It is done.’ Then there were lightning flashes, rumblings, and peals of thunder, and a great earthquake. It was such a violent earthquake that there has never been one like it since the human race began on earth. The great city (*Jerusalem*) was split into three parts, and the gentile cities fell..... Every island fled, and mountains disappeared. Large hailstones like huge weights came down from the sky on people, and they blasphemed God for the plague of hail because this plague was so severe.”
- d) Coming of Messiah – Conquering King of Kings & Lord of Lords Rev. 19:11-16
- “Then I saw the heavens opened, and there was a white horse; its rider was (called) ‘Faithful and True.’ He judges and wages war in righteousness. His eyes were (like) a fiery flame, and on his head were many diadems. He had a name inscribed that no one knows except himself. He wore a cloak that had been dipped in blood, and his name was called the Word of God. The armies of heaven followed him, mounted on white horses and wearing clean white linen. Out of his mouth came a sharp sword to strike the nations. He will rule them with an iron rod, and he himself will tread out in the wine press the wine of the fury and wrath of God the almighty. He has a name written on his cloak and on his thigh, ‘King of kings and Lord of lords.’”

B. Messiah Enthroned on Earth

Nazarene which Means 'Branch-Man' [Matt. 2:23]), and where he is he shall sprout, and he shall build the temple of the LORD." (Zech. 6:11-12)

- a) Crown of Silver (*Redemptive King*) & Gold (*Divine King*) Placed on Jesus (*Yeshua*) Christ's (*Messiah's*) Head (*Crowned as King & High Priest*)
- 2) "Yes, he shall build the temple of the LORD, and taking up the royal insignia, he shall sit as ruler upon his throne. The priest shall be put at his right hand, and between the two of them there shall be friendly understanding." (Zech. 6:13)

C. Messiah's Judgment of All Nations

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit upon his glorious throne, and all the nations will be assembled before him. And he will separate them one from another, as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will place the sheep on his right and the goats on his left.

- "Then the king will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.....'
- "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.....'" Matt. 25:31-46

Observations & Comments:

- There are many judgments mentioned in Scripture. In the above passage, Jesus speaks of His Judgment of the Nations at His Second Coming. These are the gentile nations/peoples who survived the "great tribulation" period and Battle of Armageddon, remaining alive at His Coming.
- Messiah – King & Supreme Judge judges and separates those peoples/nations who will enter into His Messianic Kingdom on Earth, from those peoples/nations condemned to death and hell. The criteria of His judgment is: 1) those peoples/nations who, sometimes unknowingly, advanced His Kingdom by showing compassion and giving aid to "His Brethren" (i.e. Jews & Christians), and 2) those peoples/nations who persecuted, refused to aid or ignored the plight of "His Brethren".
- Those peoples/nations judged worthy to enter Messiah's Earthly Reign will remain in the natural, living, marrying, procreating, etc., making up the population of a world ruled by Messiah (See Part II.D Below).

1. Messiah – God's Righteous Judge

 - c) “**I (Jesus) cannot do anything on my own; I judge as I hear, and my judgment is just, because I do not seek my own will but the will of the one (Father God) who sent me.**” *(John 5:30)*

2. Messiah Secures His Kingdom

Note. In the ancient middle east, it was common practice for a new king to secure his reign by judging, and, if necessary, eliminating overt opposition to his throne/kingdom. When Solomon ascended to Israel's Throne, he executed the judgment his father King David had requested on those officials who rebelled or violently opposed David's authority (1 Kings 2). In the same way, Messiah “Son of David” will secure His Kingdom on Earth by judging those peoples/nations that opposed His Kingdom throughout the ages.

mountains: that of an immense throng! Listen! the noise of kingdoms, nations assembled! The LORD of hosts is mustering an army for battle. They come from a far-off country, and from the end of the heavens, The LORD and the instruments of his wrath, to destroy all the land.”

(*Isa. 13:3-5*)

- b) “Lo, the day of the LORD comes, cruel, with wrath and burning anger; To lay waste the land and destroy the sinners within it! The stars and constellations of the heavens send forth no light; The sun is dark when it rises, and the light of the moon does not shine. Thus I will punish the world for its evil and the wicked for their guilt. I will put an end to the pride of the arrogant, the insolence of tyrants I will humble. I will make mortals more rare than pure gold, For this I will make the heavens tremble and the earth shall be shaken from its place, At the wrath of the LORD of hosts on the day of his burning anger.” (*Isa. 13:9-13*)
- c) “And Babylon, the jewel of kingdoms, the glory and pride of the Chaldeans, Shall be overthrown by God like Sodom and like Gomorrah.” (*Isa. 13:19*)

 (*World’s Systems: Political, Financial, Academic, Business, Religious, etc.*)
 (*Symbolically Referred to as “Babylon” & “Ship of Tyre”*)
- 1) Ship of Tyre (*Center of World Commerce*)
 - 2) “..... Fallen, fallen is Babylon, And all the images of her gods (*Idolatry – Spiritualism, Materialism & Human Power/Authority*) are smashed to the ground.” (*Isa. 21:9*)
 - 3) “..... Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great. She has become a haunt for demons.... For all the nations have drunk the wine of her licentious passion. The kings of the earth had intercourse with her, and the merchants of the earth grew rich from her drive for luxury.” (*Rev. 18:2-3*)
 - a) Instant Judgment. “..... Alas, alas, great city, Babylon, mighty city. In one hour your judgment has come.” (*Rev. 18:10*)
- f. Judgment of Gentile Nations [*References Modern Nation*]

Comment: *Seir is Esau's Land Possession (“Esau is Edom” Gen. 36) consisting of a mountain range in Edom (SE Jordan) separating Israel from Arabian Peninsula. I believe that “Seir” represents Islamic States that seek to destroy Israel.*

- Judgment: Destruction & Desolation
 - Hatred of Israel. “Because you never let die your hatred for the Israelites, whom you delivered over to the power of the sword at the time of their trouble.....” (Ezek. 35:5)
 - Guilty of Israel's Blood. “..... as I live, says the Lord GOD, you have been guilty of blood, and blood, I swear, shall pursue you.” (Ezek. 35:6)
 - Rejoiced Over Israel's Downfall
- 2) Sampling of Other Nations Prophesied Against – Prefiguring Messiah’s Judgment & Condemnation
- a) Isaiah’s Prophecy Against Assyria [*Syria & Iraq*] Isa. 14:24-27

D. Messiah’s Kingdom on Earth

1. Overview of Messiah’s 1,000 Year Reign Rev. 20:1-6
(*Israel's Messianic / Golden Age*) (*Christ's Millennial Kingdom*)
 - a. Satan Expelled from Earth. “Then I saw an angel come down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the abyss and a heavy chain. He seized the dragon, the ancient serpent, which is the Devil or Satan, and tied it up for a thousand years and threw it into the abyss, which he locked over it and sealed, so that it could no longer lead the nations astray until the thousand years are completed. After this, it is to be released for a short time.” (Rev. 20:1-3)
 - 1) Dragon (Satan) Captured & Chained for 1,000 Years
 - 2) Hurlled into Abyss (*Bottomless Pit = Place of No Escape*)

- 3) Abyss Closed & Sealed Over Him
- 4) Satan Removed from Earth & Away from Mankind During Christ's Reign
 - Unable to Seduce the Nations
- b. Establishment of Thrones. "Then I saw thrones; those who sat on them were entrusted with judgment....." (Rev. 20:4)
 - 1) Saints Empowered to Judge
(Authorities Appointed & Empowered by Christ to Judge / Govern the World)
(Rightly Dividing the Nations' Inheritance in Christ's Kingdom)
- c. The First Resurrection (In Christ's Kingdom)
 - 1) Spirits of the Righteous Dead. "..... I also saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, and who had not worshiped the beast or its image nor had accepted its mark on their foreheads or hands. They came to life and they reigned with Christ for a thousand years." (Rev. 20:4)

Note on Martyrs. The context of this Scripture implies that these are people who were martyred during the reign of Antichrist. I believe the Church, including its multitudes of martyrs, would have already been caught up into Heaven by Christ, and will Return with Christ to destroy Antichrist and his armies (See Parts II.A.1 & II.A.2 Above).

- a) Beheaded (Martyrs) for Witness to Jesus
 - Never Worshipped Beast (Antichrist / World Systems) or His Image (Antichrist's Idolatry / False Religions)
 - Never Accepted Marks on Foreheads or Hands (Allegiance to Satan, Antichrist or Evil Authorities)
- b) Came to Life Again (Resurrected)
- c) Reigned with Christ 1,000 Years (People Persecuted for Righteousness Sake have an Inheritance in Christ's Kingdom)
- 2) Chant of the Righteous. "This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection. The second death has no power over these; they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for (the) thousand years." (Rev. 20:5b-6)
 - a) Happy & Holy are They who are Included in the First Resurrection
 - b) Happy & Holy are They who Live in Christ's Kingdom
 - c) Second Death (Eternal Death & Damnation) Has No Claim Over Them
 - d) They Shall Serve God & Christ as Priests & Reign with Him 1,000 Years

Note on First Resurrection. Christ Jesus Gathers All Righteous Mankind (Both Living & Dead) from All Previous Ages / Epochs to Reign with Him in His Kingdom on Earth (John 11:25-26). It's an accumulation of Old Testament Saints, the raptured Church and those martyred during Antichrist's reign.

- 3) Unrighteous Dead - Excluded from Christ's Kingdom. "The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were over." (Rev. 20:5a)
 - a) Awaiting Final Judgment (See Part II.D.8 Below)

Observation & Opinion:

As an anointed cherub, Lucifer was appointed ruler over certain celestial and terrestrial realms within God's creation. Scripture states that when Lucifer (Satan) fell, 1/3 of the "stars" fell with him (Rev. 12:3-4), symbolizing his realm. I believe Earth is part of this realm.

God did not usurp the authority He originally gave to Lucifer, but chose Earth as a battlefield to overthrow Satan and regain His fallen creation. God created man (Adam) in His own image giving him Messianic Kingdom

dominion over Earth, and commissioning him to fill and subdue Earth with offsprings (procreated in God's image). (God's Conquest was not to be based upon brutal force, but on God's love and man's free will to choose, trust and obey Him.) Satan used this opportunity to seduce man to sin, separating man from God, resulting in man abdicating his dominion over Earth to Satan.

God's Son voluntarily became a man (God's Holy Anointed One - Messiah), came to Earth, lived a sinless life in total obedience to God, and took upon himself man's penalty for sin; thereby, regaining the dominion over Earth that God originally granted to Adam. Messiah ascended and is enthroned in Heaven. He currently rules Earth through those people who accept Him as Lord and Savior (i.e. the Church), whom He commissioned to spread His Gospel filling and subduing the Earth with citizens of His Kingdom, until He returns as King of kings and Lord of lords. When He returns, Messiah will establish His Kingdom on Earth (Millennial Kingdom), appointing His people as rulers and officials continuing His conquest of all of Satan's realm until final victory.

What is Messiah's Millennial Kingdom on Earth?

1. Messiah's Rule. Messiah will establish His Kingdom and rule over the entire Earth. His form of government will be, what I call, a "Theocratic Monarchy". Messiah's Capital City is Jerusalem (where He was sacrificed and resurrected). He will be enthroned in the New Temple's Holy of Holies as God's Presence on Earth. Apparently, Messiah (King of kings) will organize His worldwide government into districts each with a presiding throne (Matt. 19:28, Rev. 20:4) under His authority. He will rule Earth with a "rod of iron" (uncompromising justice, peace, honesty, truth, power and authority). He will also be Earth's Supreme Judge, as was the king's prerogative in ancient Israel/Judah. There will be no "separation of church and state" within Messiah's Kingdom. Worship will be mandated and prescribed by Divine Authority.
2. Messiah's Kingdom Covenant. I believe that there are three governing Covenants described in Scripture.
 - The "Old Covenant" consists of several incremental covenants where God sequentially reveals Himself to man as Creator God (Elohim), Almighty God (El Shaddai), Master (Adonai), and Lord (Yahweh) with specific revelations as our Provider (Yireh), Healer (Rapha), Victor (Nissi), Sanctifier (M'kadesh), Peace (Shalom), Righteousness (Tsidkenu), Shepherd (Rohi) and God's Abiding Presence (Shammah); all pointing to the coming Messiah (Yeshua). The Old Covenant prescribed religious laws consisting of Temple Worship, Holy Priesthood with ritualistic Sacrifices, and Holy Days, Festivals and Feasts; all pointing to the coming Messiah.
 - The "New Covenant" was established by Messiah (Christ Jesus) coming to Earth, where He fulfilled all the Old Covenant's laws and prophets. Christ became our atoning sacrifice for sin and is our High Priest. He rose from the dead victorious, ascended into heaven and enthroned as both King of kings and Head of the Church (Eph. 1:22-23), from which He sent the Holy Spirit empowering us to live godly lives and continue His work of furthering His Kingdom. We, the Church (1 Cor. 12:12-31), are spiritually, individually and collectively His Temple (1 Cor. 3:16) and Royal Priesthood (1 Pet. 2:9), awaiting His return.
 - The third governing covenant, I call the "Kingdom Covenant", will be established by Messiah at His Second Coming. Having fulfilled both the Old Covenant and the New Covenant, Messiah establishes a new Temple (note the differences between the Tabernacle/Temple configurations specified in the Old Testament and the New Temple below), a new priesthood (based on the Order of Zadok not Aaron) and a new law. Under the "Kingdom Covenant", Earth is restored to the condition originally created by God in the Garden of Eden, with Messiah (Son of Man) enthroned as supreme authority (without Satan to tempt, oppress and enslave mankind) completing the cycle back to the Lord's first covenant (Edenic) with mankind.
3. Earth's Population. I believe there will be no separation of resurrected beings from natural beings, as we know today. Human population in Messiah's Kingdom will consist of:
 - The righteous dead of the Old Covenant having been resurrected with Messiah (Matt. 27:53), the resurrected/translated Church (see Part II.A.1 Above), and the dead resurrected at Messiah's second coming (see Part II.D.1.c Above), all of whom will live eternally with Him (See Part III Below). Messiah will assign each person, duties, responsibilities and authorities

throughout His realm.

- The people (Jews & Gentiles) who were living at Messiah's return and judged worthy to inherit His Kingdom (See Opening Statements in Part II.C Above) will remain alive in the natural, marry and having children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, etc. for generations throughout this 1,000 year period. These people and their descendants will be born with Adam's sinful nature, as we are today, but will live in an idyllic world without Satan's influence, temptation, and bondages of disease, poverty, etc. They will have free will, like Adam, to accept Messiah and His Salvation or to reject Him, the same as we do today. I personally believe that many more people will be saved during the Millennial Kingdom than were saved from Adam's fall until today. The Millennial Kingdom will also prove that even with idyllic conditions, mankind will still reject and rebel against the Lord God Almighty and His Messiah.

2. Messiah's Rule – His Government

a. Messiah-King Ruler of the Whole World

In holy splendor before the daystar (*Son of God*), like the dew I begot you.'" Psa. 110:1-3
- 4) Messiah – High Priest. "The LORD has sworn and will not waver: 'Like Melchizedek you (*Messiah*) are a priest forever.'" Psa. 110:4
- 5) Messiah – Conquering Judge. "At your right hand is the Lord, who crushes kings on the day of wrath, Who, robed in splendor, judges nations, crushes heads across the wide earth, Who drinks from the brook by the wayside and thus holds high the head." Psa. 110:5-7

Observations & Opinions. There are major differences between the Configurations of the Old Covenant Tabernacle/Temple and the New Temple, which I believe signify a new Messianic “Kingdom” Covenant.

1. Overall Configuration.

- *The Old Covenant Tabernacle has One Entrance from the East into the Outer Court and the Inner Court, symbolizing that there is only one way into God’s Presence – the Old Covenant.*
- *The New Temple has 3 Gates into the Outer Court with corresponding Gates into the Inner Court. These 3 Entrances form a Crucifix with the Feet at the East Gate, the Hands at the North and South Gates, and the Head in the Holy of Holies, symbolizing Messiah’s fulfillment of both the Old & New Covenants by His Crucifixion.*

2. Outer Court.

- *Both Temples have an Altar of Sacrifice, revealing a continuation of Messiah’s sacrifice into the Messianic Kingdom.*
- *There is no Laver in the New Temple, revealing that the Priests in Messiah’s Kingdom have already been cleansed by His Blood of the New Covenant.*

3. Inner Court (“Nave”).

- *There is no Table of Showbread in the New Temple, which has been fulfilled by Messiah “The Bread of Life” in His first advent.*
- *There is no Lampstand in the New Temple, which has been fulfilled by Messiah “The Light of the World” in His first advent.*
- *In the New Temple Priests prepare Sacrifices & Other Duties/Residences at the North & South Entrances. These gates correspond to gates in the Outer Court. These Kingdom Priests minister at Messiah’s Right and Left Hands, since He has fulfilled both the Old and New Covenants.*
- *There is no Incense Altar in the New Temple for the Priests to intercede before the Lord for the people. Instead there is a Wooden Table before the Holy of Holies, representing Messiah’s fulfillment of 1) Israel’s Sacred Feasts, and 2) Christian Holy Communion (“This is My Body”, “This is My Blood”) of the New Covenant. Messiah as High Priest continues to make constant intercession for His people.*

4. Holy of Holies (“Space Beyond Nave” – Holy Place).

- *Instead of the Veil separating the Inner Court from the Holy of Holies, there is a Double Door symbolizing Messiah’s fulfillment of both the Old and New Covenants.*
- *There is No Ark of the Covenant in the New Temple. All of God’s Laws and Commandments have been fulfilled by Messiah in His first advent.*
- *Messiah’s Throne is in the Holy of Holies.*

Observations & Opinions. New Law (Kingdom Covenant) Summary. *The New Law is centered on the Lord's Presence (i.e. Messiah) Enthroned in the Temple (Center of Worship).*

1. *The Law points back to the Mosaic Covenant in its rituals, etc. with a selected Priesthood (the House of Zadok – a remnant of House of Aaron - who served in David's / Solomon's Kingdom which prefigured Messiah's conquest & reign.)*
2. *Blood Sacrifices (fulfilled by Christ's Sacrifice) point back to Jesus' Crucifixion & Christian*

Eucharist. (Note the configuration of Sacrificial Ceremonies and the Table of the Lord.)

3. *The Prince is puzzling. He seems to have a special intercessory role and position between the people and Messiah. He may be the resurrected King David whom Messiah appoints a Prince/Ruler over Israel during the Millennial Kingdom.*

The New Law looks like a merging of Jewish & Christian Covenants to form a New Kingdom Covenant.

5. Universal Abundance & Wealth (Reversing the Curse of Poverty) Isa. 60

- a. Messiah – Zion’s Splendor & Israel’s Blessing. “Rise up in splendor! Your (*Israel’s*) light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you”. (*Isa. 60:1*)
- b. Nations Blessed & Prosperous. “Nations shall walk by your light, and kings by your shining radiance.” (*Isa. 60:3*)
- c. Wealth of Nations Brought to Israel - Messiah’s Throne.
 - 1) “For the riches of the sea (*Gentile Nations*) shall be emptied out before you (*Israel*), the wealth of nations shall be brought to you.” (*Isa. 60:5b*)
 - 2) “All the vessels of the sea are assembled, with the ships of Tarshish in the lead, To bring your children from afar with their silver and gold, In the name of the LORD, your God, the Holy One of Israel, who has glorified you.” (*Isa. 60:9*)
- d. Universal Cooperation. “Foreigners shall rebuild your walls, and their kings shall be your attendants;.....” (*Isa. 60:10*)
- e. Peaceful & Abundant Societies. “Your gates shall stand open constantly; day and night they shall not be closed But shall admit to you the wealth of nations, and their kings, in the vanguard.” (*Isa. 60:11*)
- f. Universal Reverence. “They shall call you ‘City of the LORD,’ ‘Zion of the Holy One of Israel (*Messiah*)’.” (*Isa. 60:14c*)
- g. Israel Pride of the Ages. “Once you were forsaken, hated and unvisited, Now I will make you the pride of the ages, a joy to generation after generation.” (*Isa. 60:15*)
- h. Abundance of Wealth. “In place of bronze I will bring gold, instead of iron, silver; In place of wood, bronze, instead of stones, iron.....” (*Isa. 60:17*)
- i. Wealth from Global Peace - Messiah the Prince of Peace. “.....I will appoint peace your governor, and justice your ruler. No longer shall violence be heard of in your land, or plunder and ruin within your boundaries. You shall call your walls ‘Salvation’ and your gates ‘Praise.’” (*Isa. 60:17-18*)
- j. Knowledge & Wisdom to Gain Wealth – Messiah Our Source. “No longer shall the sun be your light by day, Nor the brightness of the moon shine upon you at night; The LORD shall be your light forever, your God shall be your glory. No longer shall your sun go down, or your moon withdraw, For the LORD will be your light forever, and the days of your mourning shall be at an end.” (*Isa. 60:19-20*)
- k. Wealth from Honest Gain. “Your people shall all be just, they shall always possess the land, They, the bud of my planting, my handiwork to show my glory.” (*Isa. 60:21*)
 1. Fiscal Growth & Strength. “The smallest shall become a thousand, the youngest, a mighty nation” (*Isa. 60:22a*)
- m. The Lord’s Promise. “I, the LORD, will swiftly accomplish these things when their time comes.” (*Isa. 60:22b*)

6. Universal Knowledge of Lord (Reversing Curse of Man’s Ignorance of God)

Excerpts from the Prophets:

- a. “There shall be no harm or ruin on all my holy mountain; for the earth shall be

filled with knowledge of the LORD, as water (*Holy Spirit*) covers the sea (*Gentile Nations*).”
Isa. 11:9

- b. “Then shall you know that I, the LORD, am your God, dwelling on Zion, my holy mountain; Jerusalem shall be holy, and strangers shall pass through her no more. And then, on that day, the mountains shall drip new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk; And the channels of Judah shall flow with water: A fountain (*Holy Spirit*) shall issue from the house of the LORD, to water the Valley of Shittim.”
Joel 4:17-18
- c. “But the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the LORD’S glory as water covers the sea.”

7. Satan's Final Rebellion (To Regain Dominion of Earth) Rev. 20:7-10

- a. “When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison. He will go out to deceive the nations at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them for battle; their number is like the sand of the sea. They invaded the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the holy ones and the beloved city. But fire came down from heaven and consumed them. The Devil who had led them astray was thrown into the pool of fire and sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet were. There they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.”
- 1) Satan Released at End of His 1,000 Year Imprisonment.
(*At the Conclusion of Messiah’s Millennial Reign on Earth*).
 - 2) Satan Seduces Nations & Gathers for War (*Mankind Living in Millennium Kingdom who have NOT Accepted Messiah Jesus as Lord & Savior are Open to Satan's Lies and Rebellion*)
 - a) They Invade Whole Country (*Israel*)
 - b) They Surround Beloved City (*Messiah’s Capital - Jerusalem*)
 - Where God's People are Encamped (*Mankind Saved & Resurrected*)
 - 3) Fire from Heaven Devours & Destroys Satan & Rebellious Armies
 - 4) Satan Captured & Thrown into Lake of Fire (*Satan Eternally Damned in Hell*)

Comment. This rebellion proves that Man (with his free will) has the capacity to sin and (without yielding to the will of God) will rebel against God, even in a perfect society. Man; therefore, cannot blame his personal sin on circumstances, temptation or evil influences.

8. The Final Judgment Rev. 20:11-15

- a. “Next I saw a large white throne and the one who was sitting on it. The earth and the sky fled from his presence and there was no place for them. I saw the dead, the great and the lowly, standing before the throne, and scrolls were opened. Then another scroll was opened, the book of life. The dead were judged according to their deeds, by what was written in the scrolls. The sea gave up its dead; then Death and Hades gave up their dead. All the dead were judged according to their deeds. Then Death and Hades were thrown into the pool of fire. (This pool of fire is the second death.) Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the pool of fire.”
- 1) Great White Throne (*Absolute & Righteous Authority*)
 - a) One (*Godhead*) Enthroned
 - b) Earth (*Mankind's Domain*) & Sky (*Satan's Domain*) Fled from His Presence

- 2) All the Dead Were Judged Before God's Great White Throne
(Death: Mankind's Curse for Sin)
(Dead from All Generations/EPOCHS – People NOT Alive in Christ's Kingdom)
- a) Sea Gave Up Dead
(Sea = Symbolizes Pagan Nations, i.e. Outside God's Grace)
 - b) Death & Hades (Hell) Gave Up their Dead
 - c) Death & Hades Itself *(All Demons, Principalities & Powers)* Thrown into Lake of Fire *(Eternal Damnation Without Defense)*
 - d) Lake of Fire is the Second Death
(Eternal Death – Eternally Separated from God)
 - e) Each Person Judged According to their Deeds *(Person's Life & Works)*
 - f) Anyone *(Mankind)* Who's Name *(Individual)* NOT Found in Book of Life *(God's Elect / Known to God)* Thrown into Lake of Fire

Comments. *Those Men not accepting God's Salvation (Names Not Written in God's Book of Life) were judged for their works; and failing God's perfect sinless standard (Achieved Only by Christ Jesus) are judged to Eternal Damnation.*

PART III - ETERNITY

A. God the Son's Fulfillment of His Messianic Rule

1 Cor. 15:20-28

1. Messiah - Son of God - Presents His Kingdom to Father God

- a. "..... then comes the end, when he (*Messiah*) hands over the kingdom to his God and Father, when he has destroyed every sovereignty and every authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death," (*1 Cor. 15:24-25*)
- b. God Is All and In All (*Perfect Unity between Triune God & Man*)
 - 1) "When everything is subjected to him (*Jesus Christ*), then the Son himself will (also) be subjected to the one who subjected everything to him, so that God may be all in all." (*1 Cor. 15:28*)

B. The New Creation

Rev. 21:1 – 22:5

1. New Heavens & New Earth

Rev. 21:1-8

- a. "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth. The former heaven and the former earth (*Physical & Spiritual*) had passed away, and the sea (*Pagan Nations*) was no more." (*Rev. 21:1*)
 - 1) God Destroys All Reminders of Sin, Recreating / Renovating those Realms
- b. New Jerusalem - Holy City of God (*God's Capital & Throne*)
 - 1) Coming Down Out of Heaven from God. "I also saw the holy city, a new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband." (*Rev. 21:2*)
 - a) Beautiful as Bride Prepared to Meet Her Husband (*Pure and Adorned*)
 - 2) Loud Voice from Throne (*God's Announcement*): "..... Behold, God's dwelling is with the human race. He will dwell with them and they will be his people and God himself will always be with them (as their God)." (*Rev. 21:3*)
 - a) They Shall be God's People
 - b) He Shall be their God Who Shall Always be with Them
 - c) He Shall Wipe Every Tear from their Eyes
 - d) There Shall be No Mourning, Wailing, Pain
 - e) Former World has Passed Away
 - *God Totally & Eternally Saves Us from Sin & All the Effects of Sin; Eternally Uniting Himself with Us*
- c. One (*Godhead*) Sat on Throne: "Behold, I make all things new!" (*Rev. 21:5a*) (*New Created Order*)

 - 12 Gates with 12 Angels Stationed *(Guarding Entrance)*
 - 12 Gates with Names of the 12 Tribes of Israel
(Perfect Obedience & Fulfillment of Law Required for Entrance)

 - 12 Courses of Stones *(Solid Foundation)*
 - 12 Names of Apostles of Lamb
(Foundations Built on Gospel of Jesus Christ)

 - Glory of God Gives Light *(Illuminated by God's Glory)*
 - Its Lamp is the Lamb *(Jesus Christ the Light of World)*
